OVERVIEW

The Department of Geography, Shri Krishan Chander Government Degree College Poonch is a key component of the college's Science stream. Established as part of the broader institution founded on November 11, 1955, the department serves both regular undergraduate students and those enrolled through the Directorate of Distance Education, University of Jammu. It emphasizes practical learning and caters to the educational needs of students from Poonch and surrounding areas, focusing on geographical concepts, population studies, and physical geography. The college itself is a co-educational general degree institution accredited with an 'A' grade by NAAC, offering courses across arts, science, and commerce to promote accessible higher education for lower- and middle-class communities in Jammu and Kashmir.

Programs Offered

- The department delivers undergraduate programs aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, primarily through the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) in Geography.
- B.Sc. Geography (Honour/Research): Available across semesters 1st through 7th, with options for honour and research tracks.
- Semester-Specific Admissions: Structured under CUET (Common University Entrance Test) and Non-CUET routes, including provisional merit lists, counselling, and spot rounds for sessions like 2023-24 and 2024-25.
- Distance Education Support: Integrated programs for external learners via University of Jammu.
- Admission Process: Involves merit-based allocation, with forms, prospectuses, and guidance videos available (e.g., for FYUGP Semester 1st, 2024-25). Seat matrices include fee structures, and admissions emphasize NEP-compliant multidisciplinary approaches.
- Program outcomes focus on developing skills in spatial analysis, environmental awareness, and research methodologies, with documented course-specific outcomes for each semester.

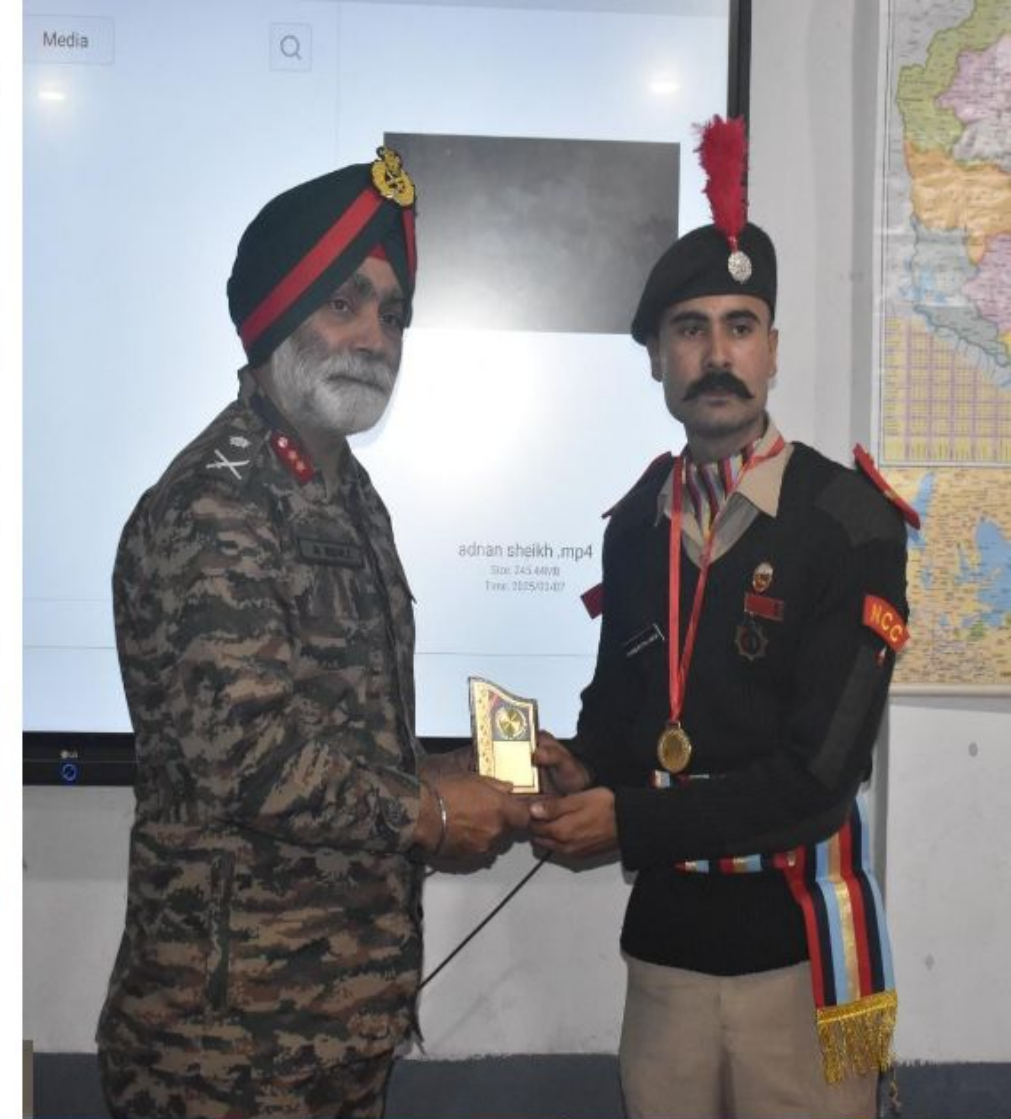


Map of India on Ground under Department of Geography on eve of Independence Day

Department of geography has various surveys prescribed in syllabus

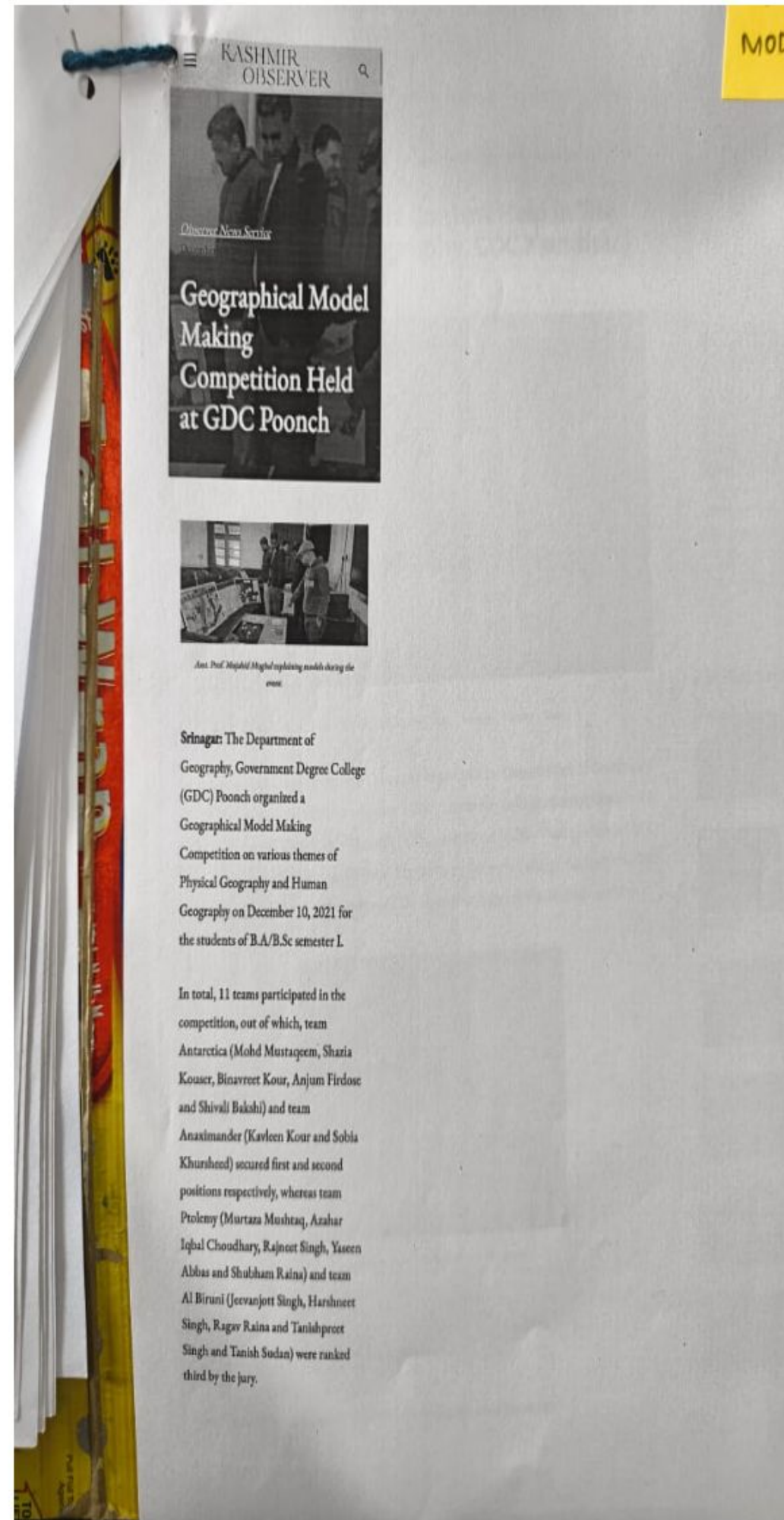
(a) Plane table Survey (b) Chain and Tape Survey (c) Dumpy level Survey.

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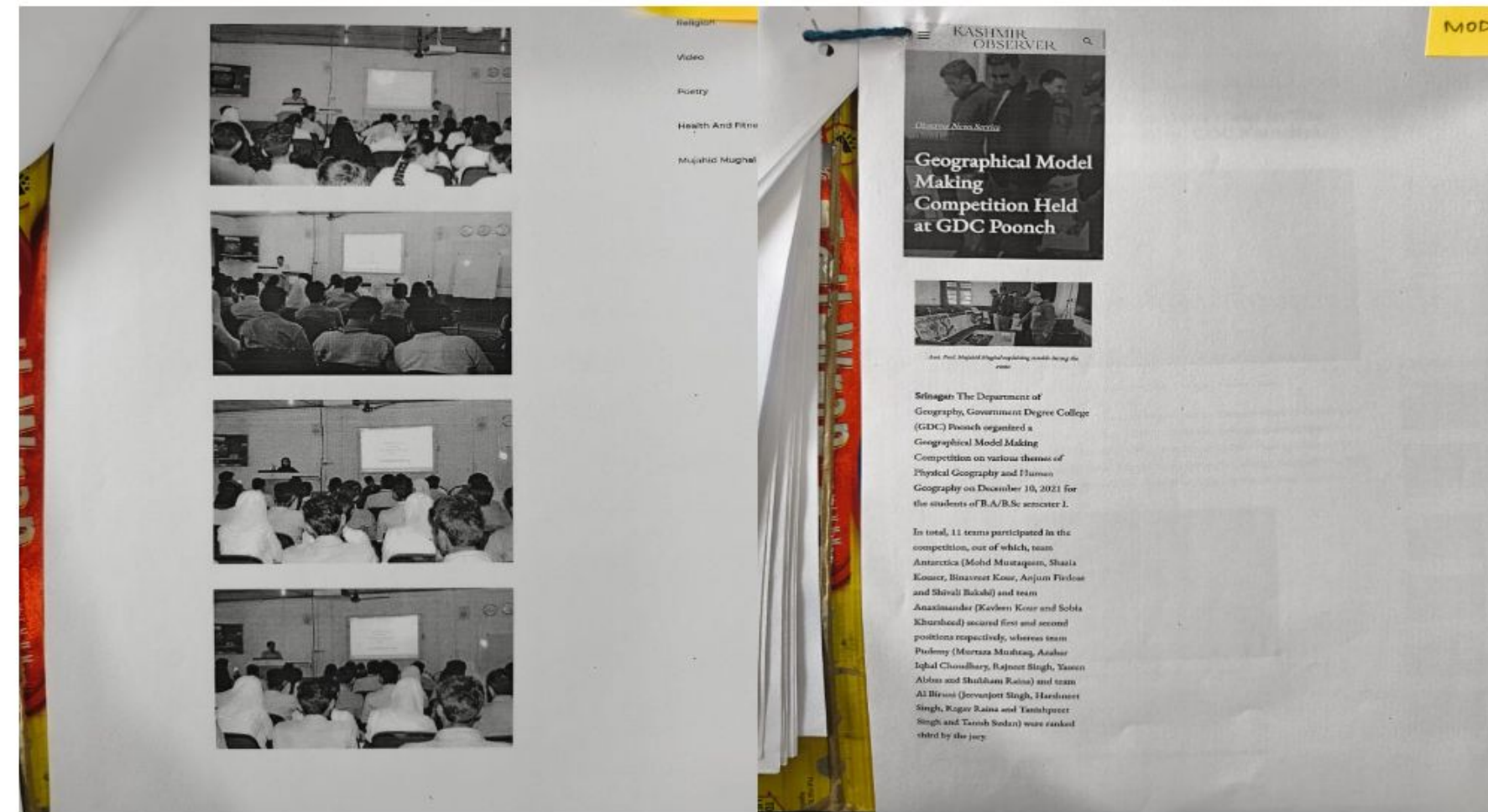

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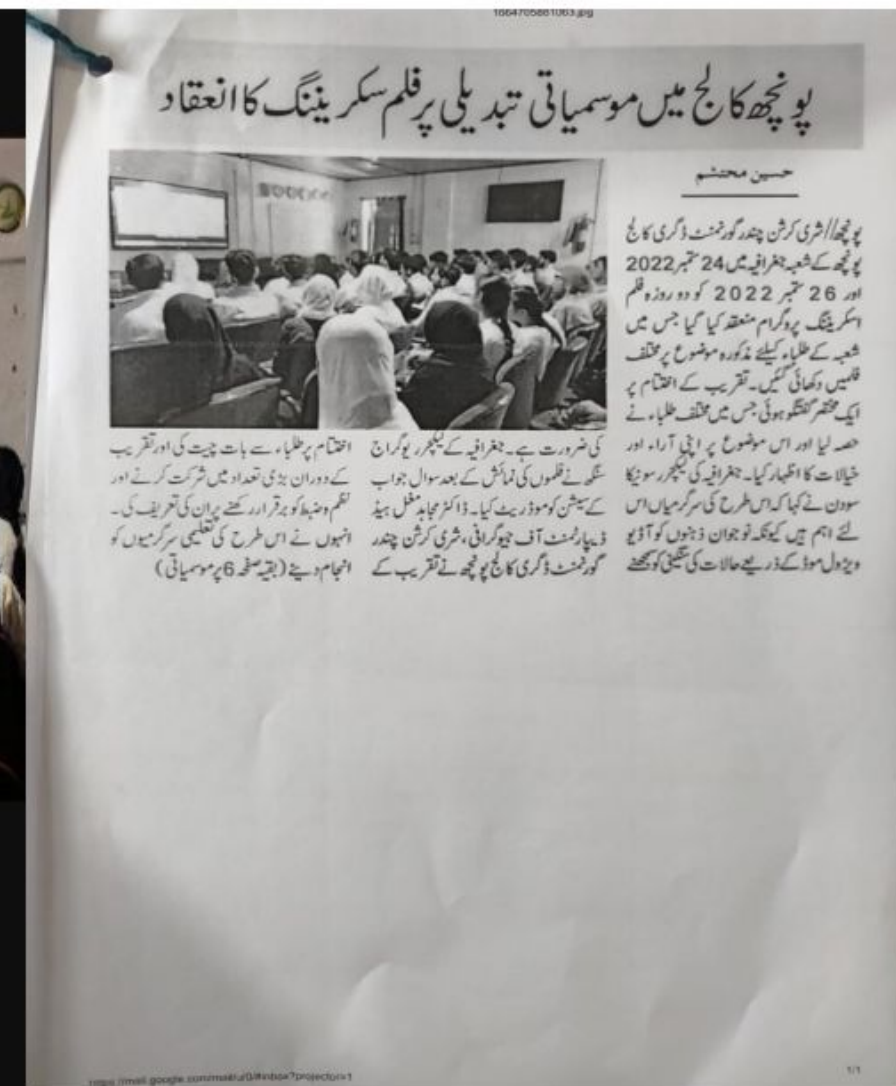


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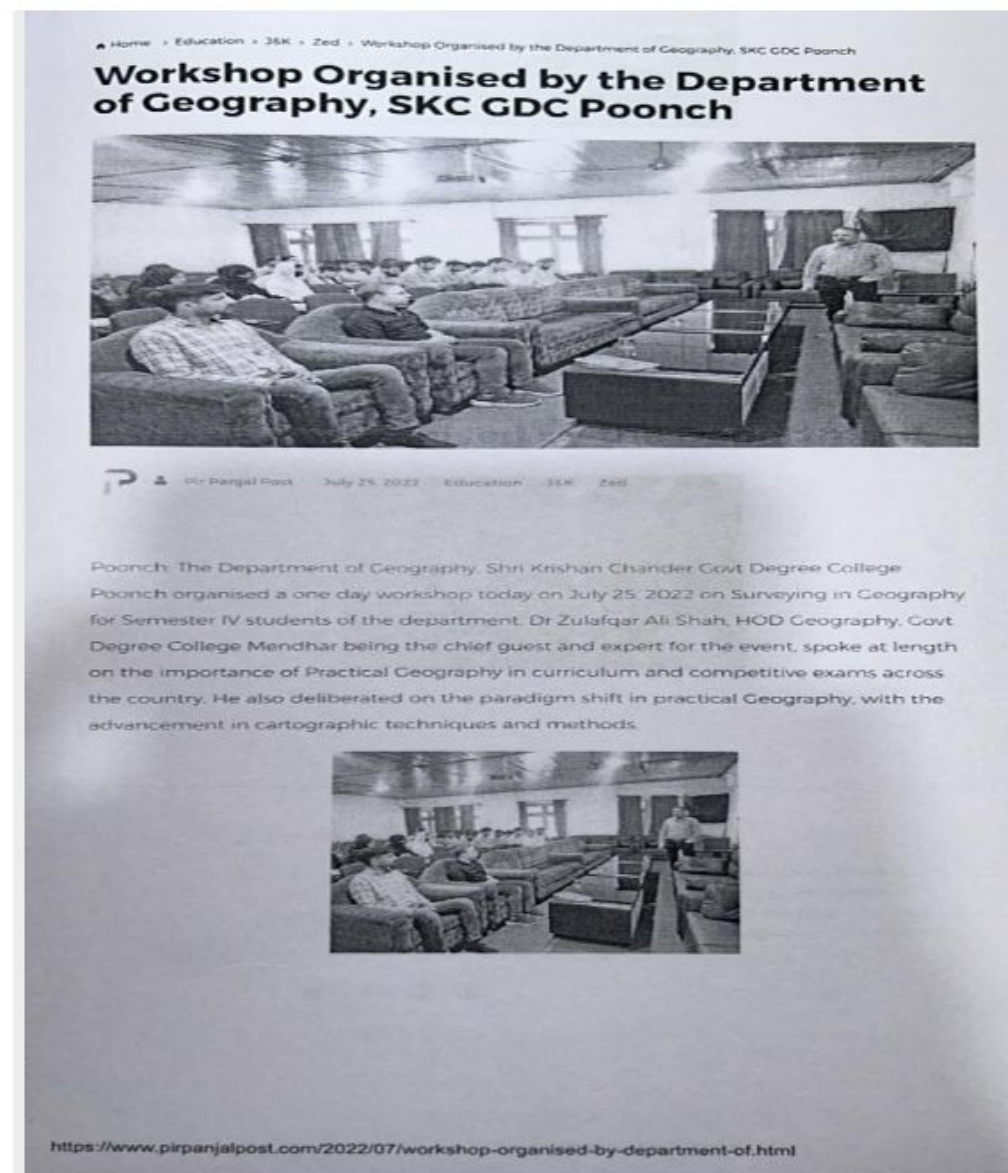


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Workshops and Extension Lectures
